How to Begin a Ministry

You are invited to begin a ministry!

If you feel a burden for an unmet need in this church, our community or around the world God may be calling you to begin a ministry.

Step #1 **Pray** and ask God for His guidance.

Step #2 **Talk it up.** Talk to others about this need and seek their advice.

Step #3 **Talk to your deacon or a pastor.** We will not ask you if you have all the details of the ministry figured out. God commonly calls us and, after we step out, guides us and meets the needs. We do ask, however, that your plan and vision reflect CrossPointe Fellowship's beliefs, priorities, moral standards and ministry style.

Step #4 **The church leadership announces the possibility to the church.** This is to see if Jesus, our senior pastor, desires the launch this ministry at this time. If He does He will call the adequate number of volunteers required (who will hopefully be obedient to His calling). A church leader will announce a meeting time and location for all interested in this ministry. If enough people respond we move ahead. If there are not enough people to carry out this ministry effectively it may not be God's timing to begin this ministry yet.

Step #5 **Organize.** Develop a practical purpose and vision statement, ministry strategy, leadership structure and financial accountability system.

Step # 6 **Raise the finances and resources.** A self-supporting ministry is much easier to start. Some proving time may be necessary before the ministry is represented in the church budget.

Step # 7 Launch the ministry
